Top right of the home page is where you can log in to the Members Home Page




Your **user name** is the email address you use with WHRADA.

The menu :

Finds: Upload details of important finds. Here you can:

1. Upload an image of your find (this will appear in the gallery).
2. Upload details of the find (Eventually there will be a table of finds lower down the page).
3. Add a pin to the map, showing the find (the pin is moderated, so doesn't appear instantly).

Finds Gallery: Images of important finds (see above).

Stories: Members stories. Send in your stories and they will appear here (admin@whrada.website)

Club Honours: Awards and Trophies awarded by the club.

Noticeboard: Items for sale/wanted and other notices. Email them to admin@whrada.website.
